School Performance Data:

Year 6: On Tuesday 9th July we were notified that 90.4% of our pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading, SPAG and Maths. The average for greater depth hasn't yet been released, however, if it is in line with last academic year's, we are expecting over 60% of children working at the higher standard.
A massive congratulations to all the children for their achievements and the Year 6 team, in particular Miss Jo and Miss Donna for all your hard work.

Similarly, a massive well done to the Key Stage One children and their team!

Year 2 teacher assessment results this year are:
Expected Standard - 83% Reading, 81% Writing and 85% Maths
Greater Depth Standard – 35.7% Reading, 33.3% Writing, 47.6% Maths
