Dear All,

I am sure you are all aware of the government's recent announcements surrounding education and some of you will be wondering how this impacts on you and your family. I writing to confirm that from Tuesday 5th January, school will be open to the children of critical workers and vulnerable children only. We will be sending out a letter on Monday outlining our provision for Remote Learning and in school learning in greater detail.

The list of critical workers has been collated from request we sent out in November following the government's guidelines. We will contact all vulnerable children on Monday to confirm your child's place. School we will be open from 8:30 and finish at 3:15; we are endeavouring to keep afterschool care going, provided that we have enough staff.

It goes without saying, for all the children at home, our remote learning package will be on offer. We will start this fully on Wednesday 5th with a live Google Meet and following lessons. We ask that you check that you can log onto google classroom (and Tapestry and Sharepoint for Reception) before this date, if you have any technical issues please email the office: admin@judithkerr.anthemtrust.uk and these can be rectified before Wednesday.
