To support the cause, we are asking for donations of £2 or whatever amount you can.

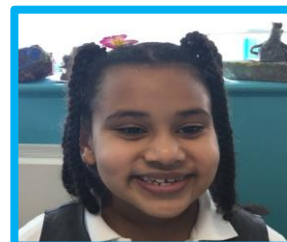
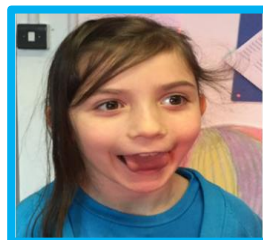
