Nursery

Many of you have been asking about the Nursery and finally we have heard back from the DFE. They have asked that we resubmit our proposal. Our first proposal was via the fast-track route and we will now apply again using the more formal route.

The main reason for this is that Southwark Council have raised concerns about the nursery opening and we need to show how we can negate these: in particular we need to demonstrate that the demand for our nursery is contextual to school and will not negatively impact surrounding nurseries. So, this means we will need to repeat parts of the consultation process: we will be sending out a new questionnaire and ask that all parents respond with the same positivity that we did last time.

Consequently, we will definitely not be opening in September but are looking to try and open in January. We know that this puts many of you in a tricky position and we can only apologise and thank you for your continued support.

CEO Visit

On Wednesday, we had visit from Andy Yarrow (Anthem's CEO), Karen Walker (our Educational Director) and Sam Coy (our new Educational Director from September), with our LGB representatives Amy Teichman and Katherine Leopold.

It was a really positive day and they commented on the positive learning atmosphere, our creative curriculum and how this was developing children as citizens of the world. They also noted that, despite the pandemic, the standard of the children's work was broadly in line with where it should be. So, a huge well done to the teachers and all the children.

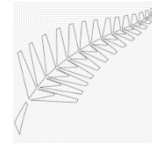
